English

In Reception this half term we are starting to listen to different sounds and we will begin to introduce the first phonemes. The year 1 children will be revisiting sounds as well as developing their phonic knowledge and begin to write instruction sentences.

English in Sycamore Class
We will be learning about instructions. We will think about sequencing, verbs, time conjunctions and using capital letters and full stons

Maths

As a class we are all focusing on place value within 10. We have been counting to 10 forwards and backwards as well as sorting different objects to 10. The year 1 children will be encouraged to record their numbers too.

order and represent number, using place value.

Learning Across the Curriculum

The children have been playing team games during PE inside and outside. They have been practicing balancing and copying different actions. This term a main focus of PE will be childrens' health and self-care. The children will be encouraged to change independently and think about their heart rate and ways to keep healthy.

The children have been introduced to the school's Core Values; we have created different pieces of art to show their involvement in the school. The children will now be encouraged to think about appropriate responses to situations, using appropriate language to express their feelings and that everyone deserves respect.
