## English

We will be exploring poetry, plays and news reports and using these genres to consolidate our learning ready for junior school. We will also be practicing our speaking and listening skills in play rehearsal.

### English in Sycamore Class

In English we will be learning to use persuasive language. We are also going to investigate poetry. Then we are going to read a finding tale about a child who goes on a journey. We will explore the settings he visits as part of his journey.

## Maths

In Maths we will be consolidating our work on number, revisiting 2D and 3D shape, revising our money work as well as looking at fractions of amounts.

### Maths in Sycamore Class

In Maths we are beginning to learn about multiplication in the context of grouping things into twos, fives and tens to make them easier to count. We will then consider how this knowledge can help us with sharing for division.

## Learning Across the Curriculum

We will be investigating different journeys and taking a virtual trip around the United Kingdom and learning about what makes these four separate countries special. We will also be working on our map skills, and thinking about our own personal journey in the world, both past, present and future. We will also be cooking our way across the UK with four delicious recipes, making use of our brand new purpose built cookery room.
