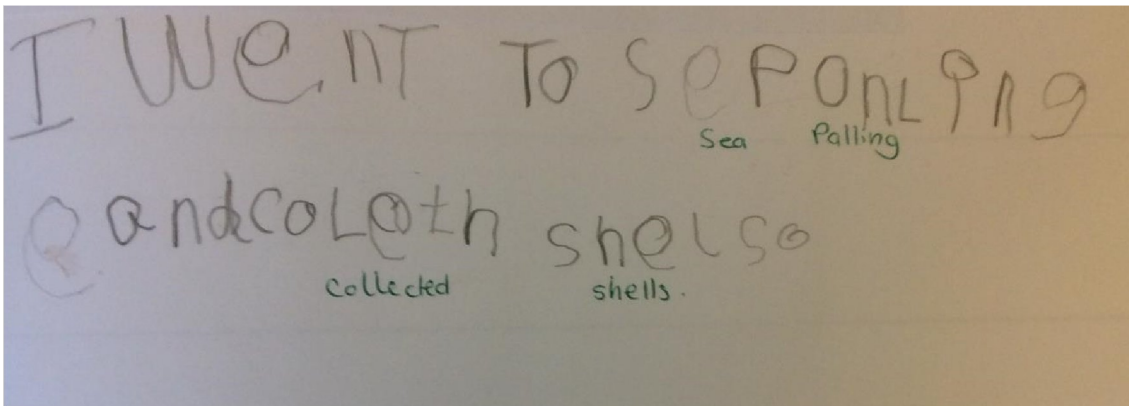


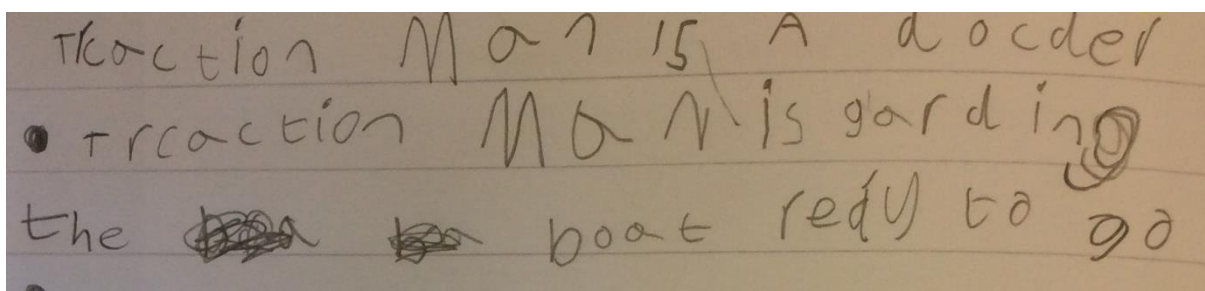
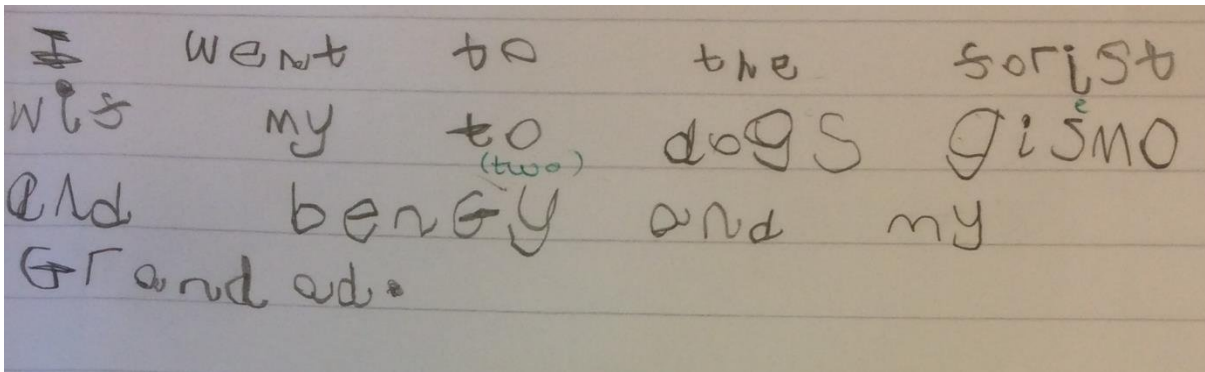
Writing presentation

English

Reception children will continue to develop their blending and segmenting skills. As always the children will be encouraged to write in their play as well as through guided writing activities.

Maths

This half term we will be learning about counting reliably and ordering numbers; year 1 children will learn about place value in 2 digit numbers. We will also continue to develop strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems. Through practical activities the children will develop their vocabulary and apply their skills. Reception children will continue to develop their counting skills and explore addition and subtraction through practical activities
