Learning Across the Curriculum

This half term we will be comparing the work of artists Henri Mattise and Wassily Kandinsky. We will be using a wide range of media including; water colours, pastels, crayons, collage and clay to create different artworks in the style of these artists. As music was the main influence in Kandinsky's work, we will be listening to some of the classical pieces which inspired him to recreate some of our own artwork.

In science we will be learning about animals in their habitats and learn about micro-habitats such as ponds. We will be learning about how a habitat can provide the basic needs for animals and plants and how they depend on each other.

With our Secret Agent work this half term, children will be reading and answering comprehension questions in class and please keep reading your books regularly at home.
