#### **Questionnaire Results**

#### Year 2 Special Work (SATs)



Throughout May, all Year 2 children across the country will be completing statutory assessments (SATs). The results from these assessments are used to inform how teachers grade a child's overall achievements in English and Maths at the end of Year 2. We aim for every child to be able to do their best in these assessments but recognise that children learn at different rates. While most children will meet the government's expected standard at this time, others will exceed this and others will not meet this standard yet. For all children, please read regularly, complete other homework tasks set, promote sleep, a healthy active life-style and avoid placing pressure on children. This year, Spixworth Infant School have also been selected to trial some new questions in Maths. This trial will take place on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May. As this trial is a test of the questions, not the children's ability to answer them, there will be no results recorded or shared from this. A separate letter for parents of children included in this trial will follow.

# Year 1 Special Work (Phonic Screening)

During the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> June, all Year 1 children (and those children in Year 2 who did not pass the phonics check in Year 1) will be taking their phonic screening check. The children will be asked to read 40 words with a teacher. Some of the words are real while others are made-

up words. This makes sure that only phonic skills, not sight reading skills, are checked. Please help your child by reading regularly and practising with the phonic card sheets that are sent home weekly. #### **Transition**

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We aim to work closely with nursery and the junior school throughout the year. In the Summer term, our transition support increases.

Our Year 2 children will have two transition sessions at Woodland View Junior School after half term. One session will include a drop off at the Junior school in the morning and lunch, the other will be an afternoon session with pick up from the Junior school. This format has been very successful in previous years and allows the children to experience key times of the day in a supportive way.

If your child is in Year 2 but transitioning to a different Junior/Primary school, please let us know as soon as possible so we can link in with these activities.

Children joining us in Reception in September will receive a visit from one of our teachers to their nursery and also be invited to sessions in school including a teddy bears' picnic.

All dates will follow shortly.



# Coming Up



We have two visits coming up next half term. The first is a visit to the Hippodrome Circus for the whole school to complement our Flight topic. The second is for our Year 2 children only to Norwich Gymnastics Club for a gymnastics apparatus session. This session enhances our PE curriculum but will also be an opportunity for our Year Twos to celebrate their time together at Spixworth Infant School with a picnic and games on their return. 
