#### <u>September Information</u> <u>Children's University</u>



A number of changes have taken place over the past year within Children's University. The cost to schools has increased (now over £660 per year plus the cost of passports). Graduations are only offered to children once they have reached the 'gold' award and the ceremony itself has been minimised.

After careful consideration the governors and staff have decided not to continue with Children's University from September. We will however offer our own school version and will honour the hours children have accumulated so far through our own award system.

From September, every child will have a Learning Outside the Classroom passport. Parents can record all clubs/visits attended outside of school and we will record extracurricular learning from school visits and visitors too. There will be no cost to parents. Awards will be given at ceremonies in school, which we will make sure are just as special for the children.

Further information will be available in September.

#### <u>September Information</u> <u>Premises Plans – in brief</u>

Our Children's Centre room closes at the end of July. We are pleased to share that Stepping Stones nursery have made a bid to use this space. This will mean separate rooms for the babies and toddlers/pre-school children and more opportunities for supporting families. With increased spaces, over time we are likely to see the school benefit from larger numbers of children joining us. Once final agreements have been made, there will be some small scale building works to improve this part of the school.

We are thrilled to be benefitting from funding from Norfolk Property Services to replace our current oil boiler (which is over 30 years old!) to a new gas boiler. Works will begin in the Summer break.

Looking ahead, next year is likely to be the last year in which schools benefit from Sports Funding. We are keen to provide a canopy over part of the main playground next year. This will allow for greater outdoor learning and play for all children. We hope to combine this with improvement works to Horse Chestnut class window and the entrance from the playground.

#### Support Staff Changes

We are very sorry that our long serving caretaker and cleaner will both be leaving us after the Autumn term. We would like to thank them for their dedication to our school and wish them every success and happiness in the future.

This does mean we are looking for two new people to join us. If you, or anyone you know, would be interested in a before and after school cleaning or caretaking post, please speak to us in September for more information.



We will also be looking for reading volunteers in September. If you have any regular, spare time to support in a class to hear children read, we would love to hear from you!
