Change in Drop Off Arrangements

On return to school in January, we will be making the following changes to drop off.

- Arrive through the Ivy Road (car park) gate.
- Line up on the playground at your allotted class marker.
- Your child's class teacher will come to the playground at your staggered drop off time (these remain unchanged). The class teacher will lead the class around the building to the external classroom door.
- Parents should walk with their children to their classroom door and then continue around the one-way system and out of the Lilian Road gate.

Pick up

- Arrive through the Ivy Road (car park) gate.
- Line up on the grass (as currently in place). Children will be dismissed from classroom door as they are now.
- Exit through Lilian Road gate.

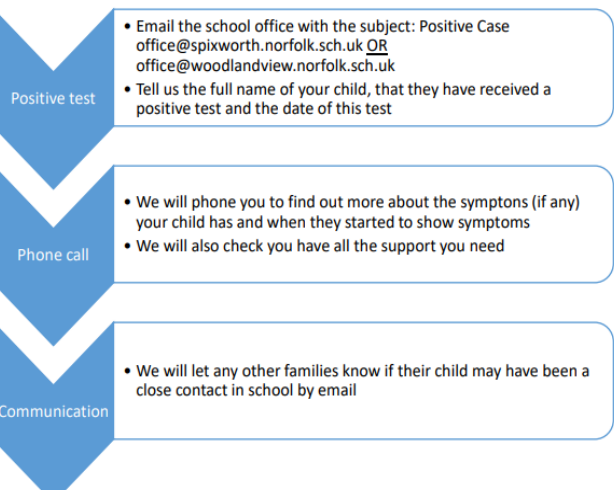
This will reduce daily footfall on the grass. PLEASE CONTINUE TO OBSERVE SOCIAL DISTANCING.
