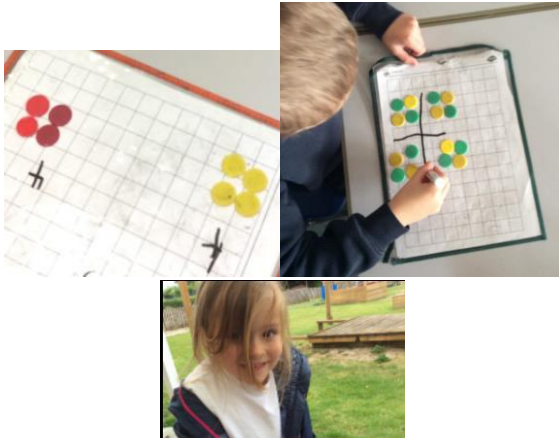


Oak Class

In Science we have been learning about materials and thinking carefully about the best materials to make our own boat

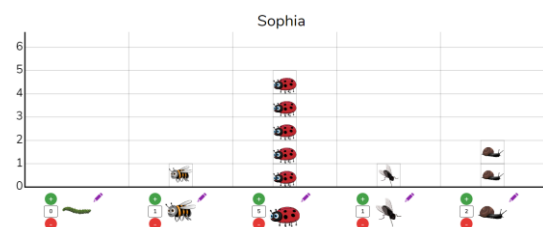


Before the half term break, we dived into the ocean and explored the wonderful Song of the Sea in English, using short clips from the sea we opened a chest and explored the magic of the ocean.
