"Noi yanked the Little grey whale all the way back home maybe they could be friends." - Seb

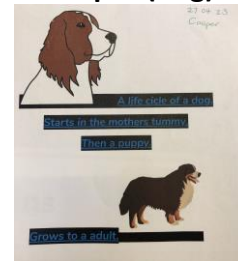
Adverbials ending in ly

"He cautiously laid his new friend (the grey whale) into the bathtub."- Theo

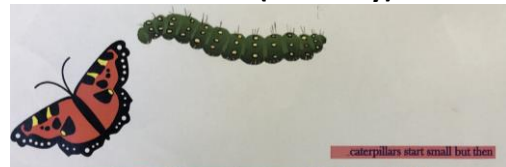
Science and Computing
