We have been experimenting with different ways to represent 9 and 10; you can see here we have used Numicon!

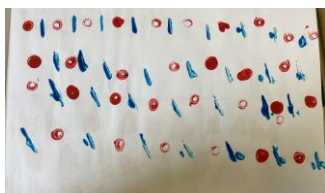


Year 1
