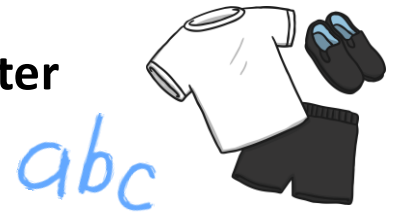




Super Sunflower Class Newsletter

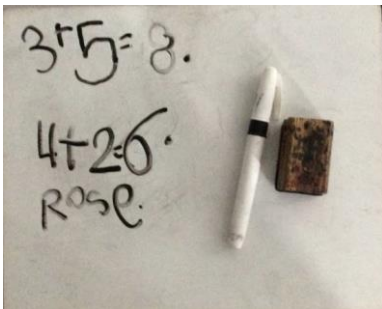
Summer 2 - 2023
