Phonics We have learnt the phonemes; h, b, f, l ss, ff, ll, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, sh, th, ch, ng and nk. Tricky words; we have learnt: put, pull, full, as, and, has his, go, no, to, into, she, push, he, of we, me and be! Well done for continuing to practice these at home!
