term?

English

This half term we are going to be diving into Matt de la Peña's book "The Last Stop on Market Street" where we follow CJ on his journey, exploring diverse communities and important values that link to our school community.

Phonics/Spellings

This half term in Year 1 we have been revisiting our Phase 3 graphemes and words. In Year 2, we have been revisiting our Phase 5 graphemes and words before we begin our Spelling Units next half term. A summary of our learning can be found on Tapestry at the end of each week.

Mathematics

This half term Year 1 will be beginning their mathematical journey looking at place value; focusing on counting, sorting and representing. Year 2 will also be focusing on place value; looking at tens and ones and how to partitioning numbers to 100.

Science and Foundation Subjects

This half term in Science we are going to be learning all about plants and animals in our local area; by identifying and comparing them. We will be focusing on wild and garden plants, and being able to describe their structures and functions.

Alongside this, in History we will be examining how Spixworth has evolved through the years and in Geography, identifying the features of our local area and why they are important.

Ask us to explain...


What is subitising?
