What will we be learning this half term?



English

This half term we will be reading 'Storm Whale' by Benji Davies.

This book will be the basis of writing sessions and drama during our English lessons this half term. Have you been to the beach before? What could you see/hear/smell?

Phonics/Spellings

Year 1 are focusing on preparing for their phonics screening in June by recapping all taught sounds and practising blending alien words.
Year 2 are carrying on with their daily spelling lessons. This half term they are learning about 'c' making the /s/ sound and how to alter words before adding suffixes.

Mathematics

This half term Year 1 are going to learn about multiplication and division! Then they will move on to fractions.

Year 2 are learning about fractions, time and statistics, whilst still revisiting the four operations.

How to solve an addition and subtraction question by drawing out our tens and ones.
