## What will we be learning this half term?

#### Welcome

A massive well done to all the children for starting their Reception year and joining our school community. We have loved getting to know you all during your home visits and can not wait to be part of your learning journey during your Reception year.

#### Phonics (Little Wandle)

From next week we will be beginning our phonics learning. We will start by learning phonemes s, a, t, p, i, n, m, n, d, g, o,c, k. Please remember to check Tapestry for our weekly phonics learning and don't forget to share your phonics practice at home!

### Mathematics (Mastering Number)

We will begin our number learning, singing lots of number songs and playing number recognition games. We will be focusing on subitising numbers to 5 and finding out about the 5—ness of 5! The Numberblocks will help us along the way and we will be using lots of manipulatives e.g. fingers, cubes and buttons to show different ways of making 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

We will be: Building friendships with our friends and our class grown-ups, thinking about ourselves/our families and how we/they maybe the same, different and unique. As we move into Autumn we will be observing changes, thinking about our world and how it transitions between the seasons, we will explore the school grounds to identify changes that will be occurring around us and choose a class tree to observe throughout the year. We will be thinking about people who help us in our daily lives and differing communities.
