What will we be learning this half term?

English

We are starting off our English learning by exploring what a biography is and reading different examples. We will look at Florence Joyner – an Olympic athlete. At the end of the unit, we will have a go at writing a biography of our own! We read with your child frequently at school. Please read with them at least three times a week at home to give them the best chance at success in KS1!

Phonics/Spellings

Year 1 are learning the phase 5 graphemes, while year 2 are completing Little Wandle Spelling lessons.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Year 1 and 2 are looking at place value within 100, making sure we have a secure understanding of these numbers. We will then move on to shape at the end of the term.
